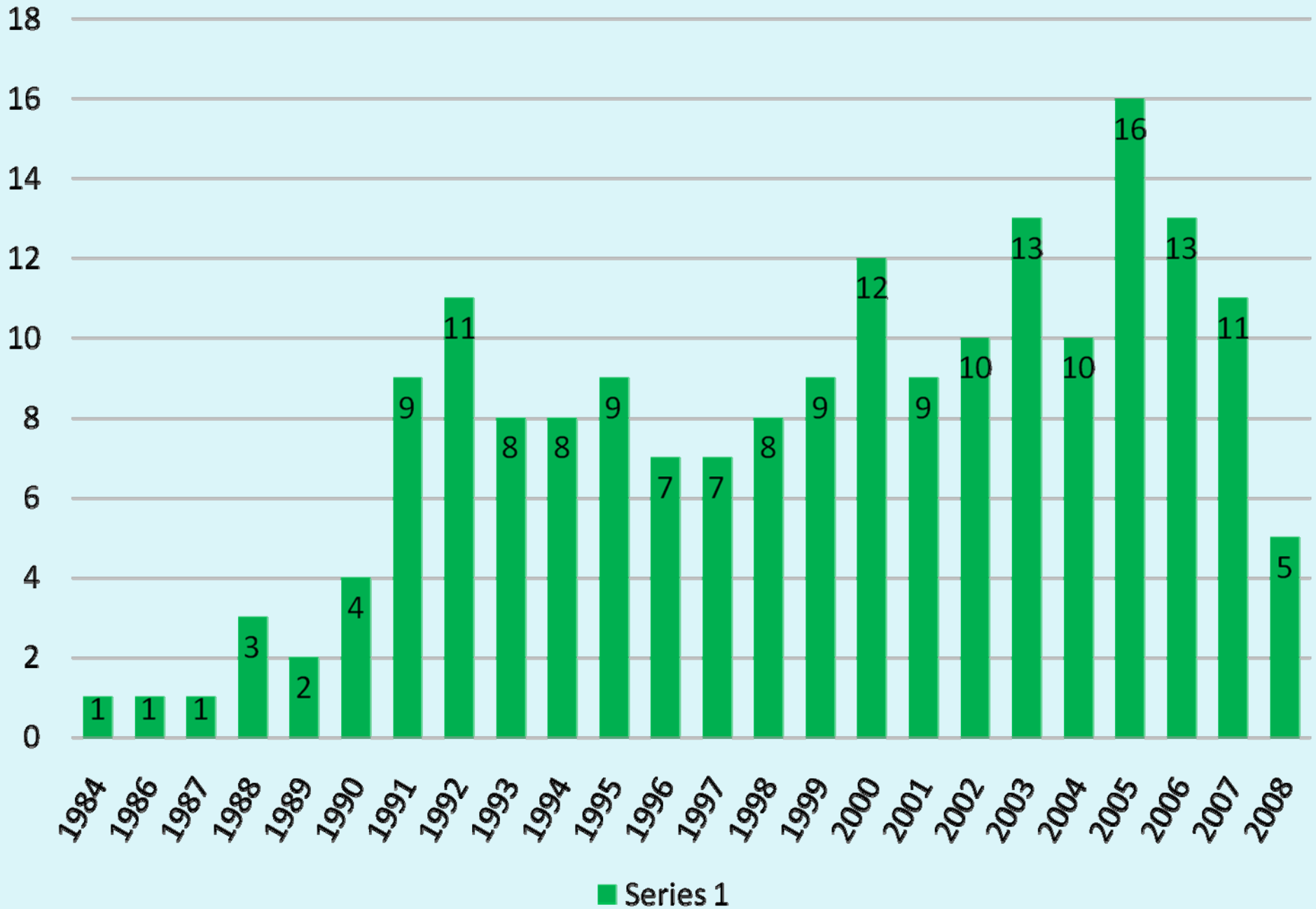

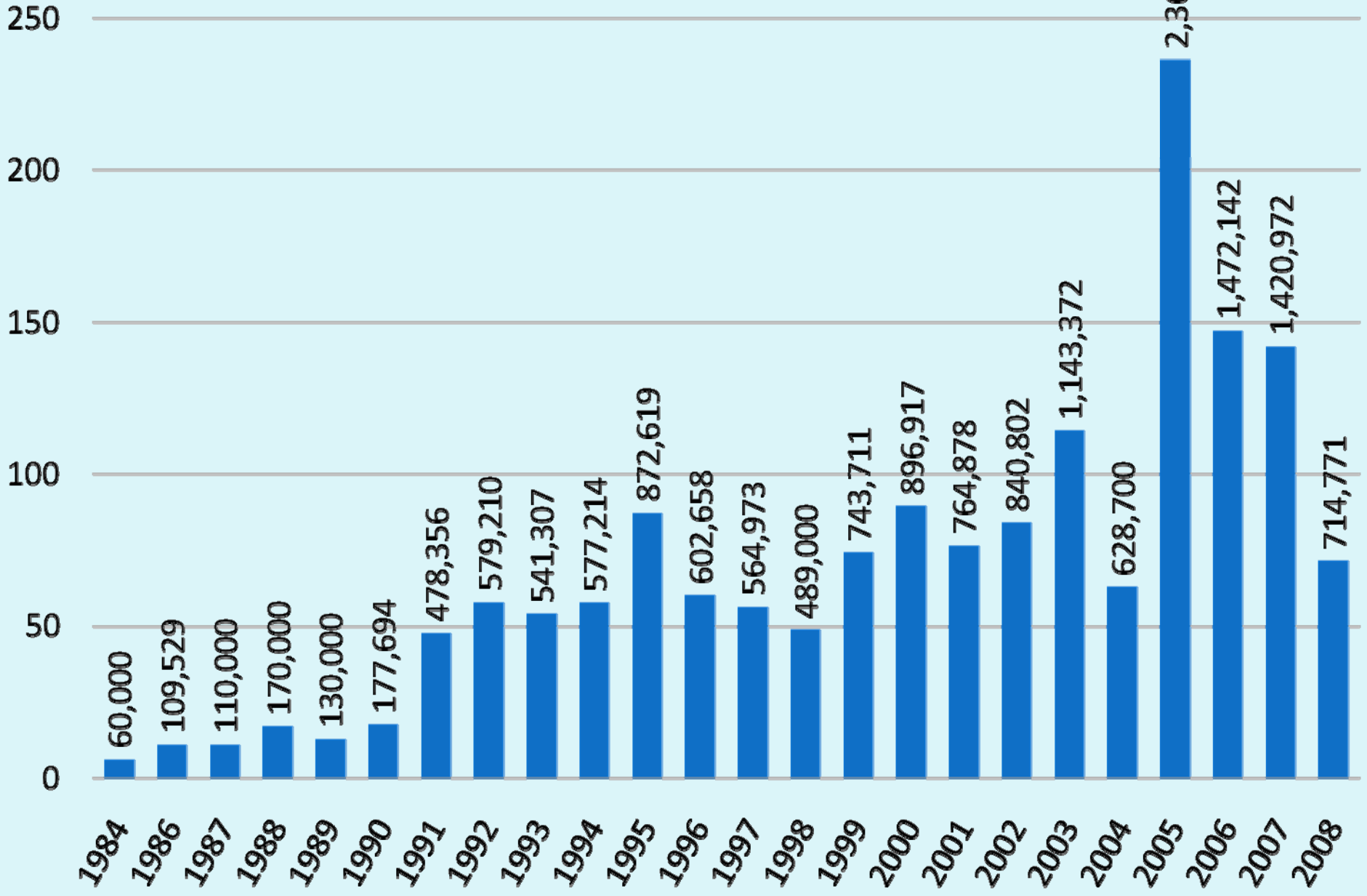

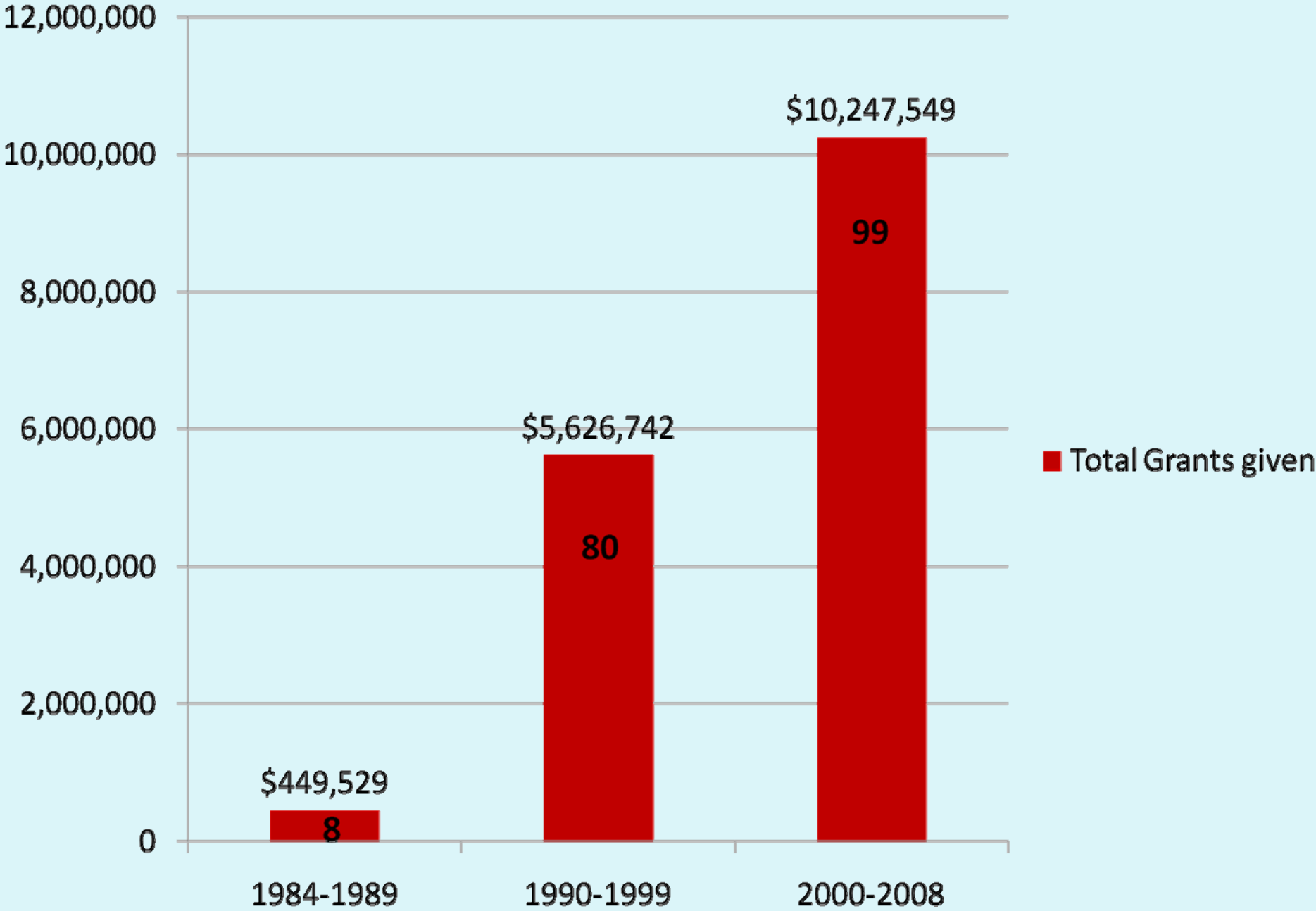
Number of Grants for Cuba from 1984 through 2008



Amount (in US Dollars) Given in Grants for Cuba from 1984 through 2008



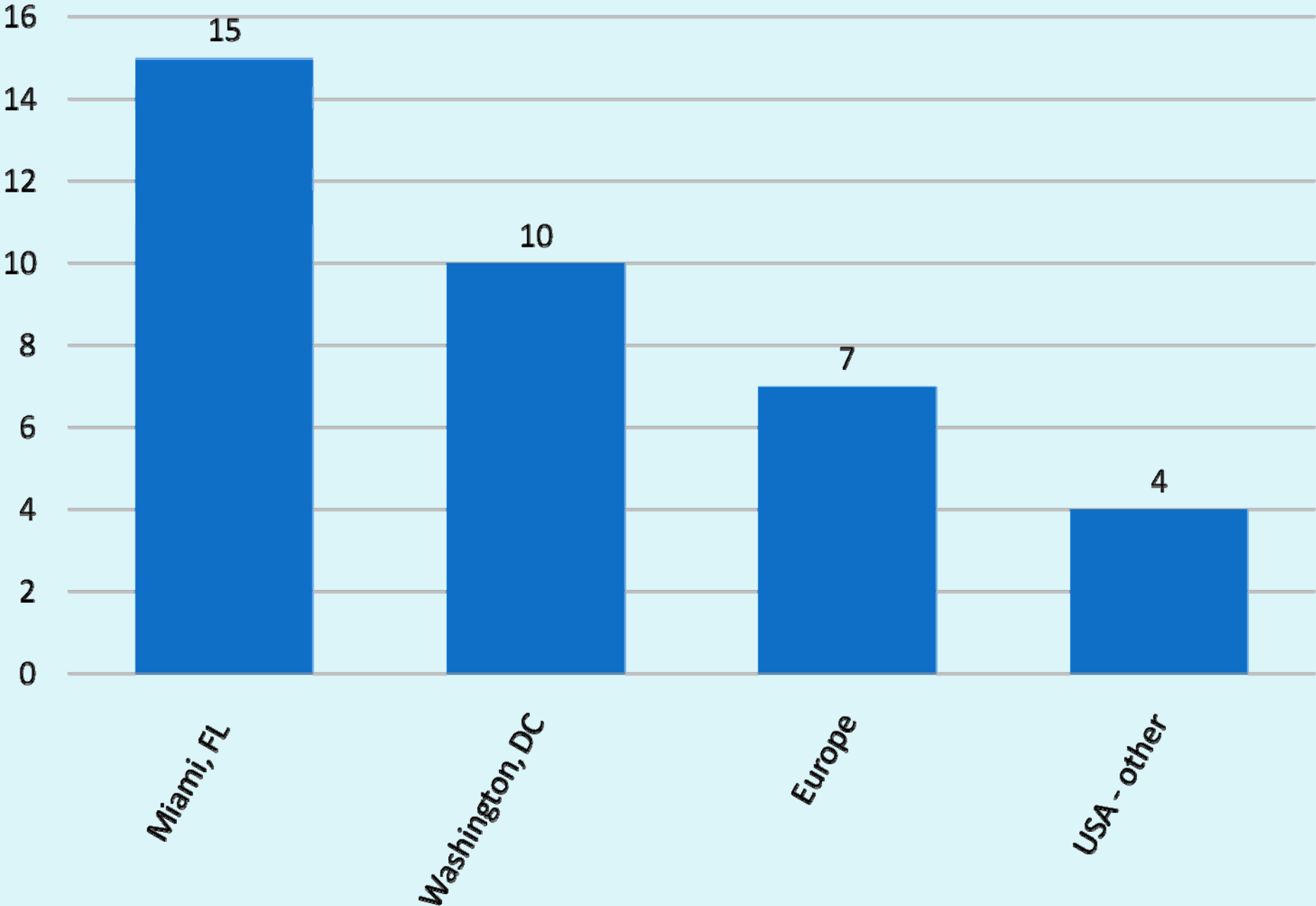

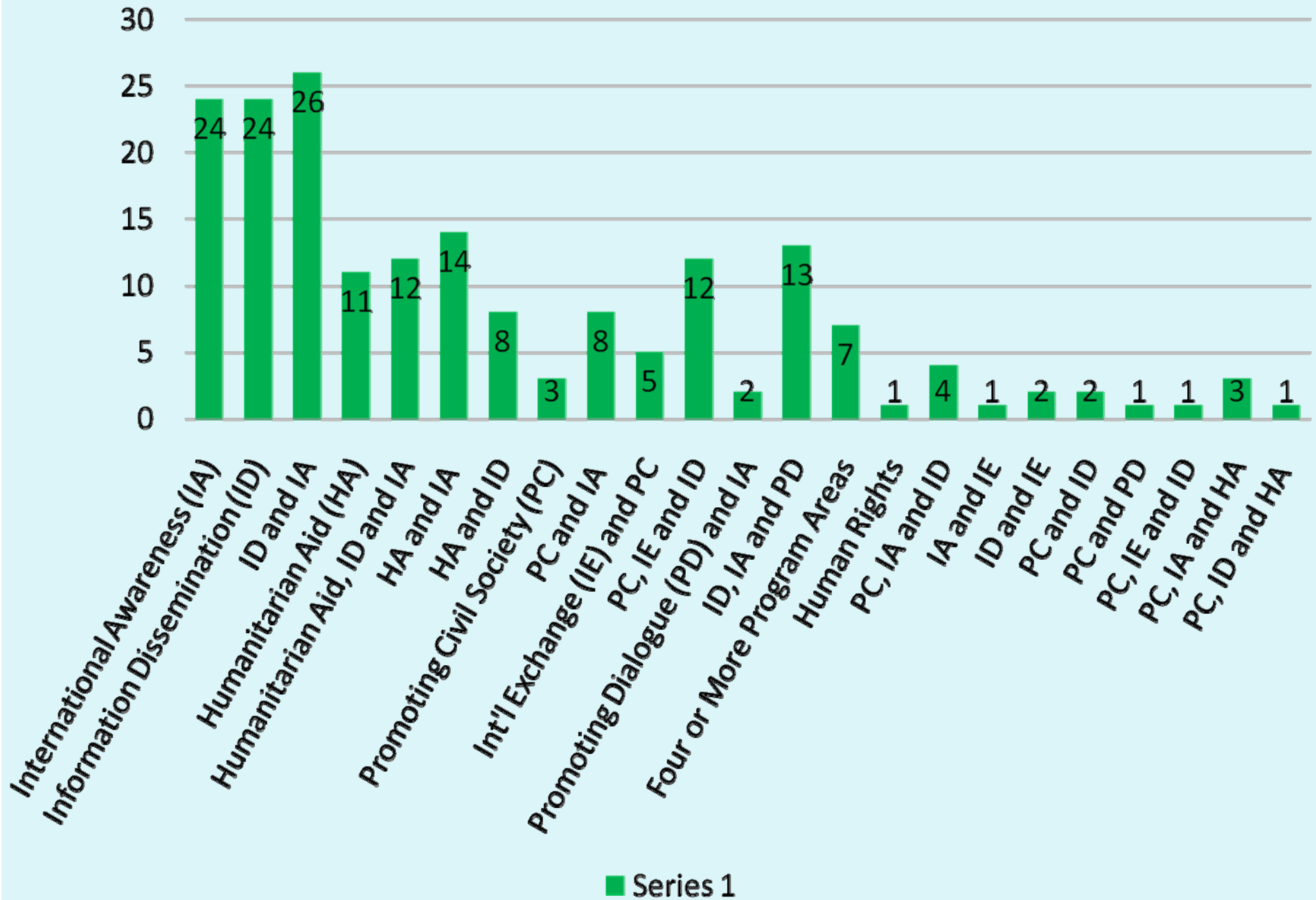
Location of Grantees Since 1984



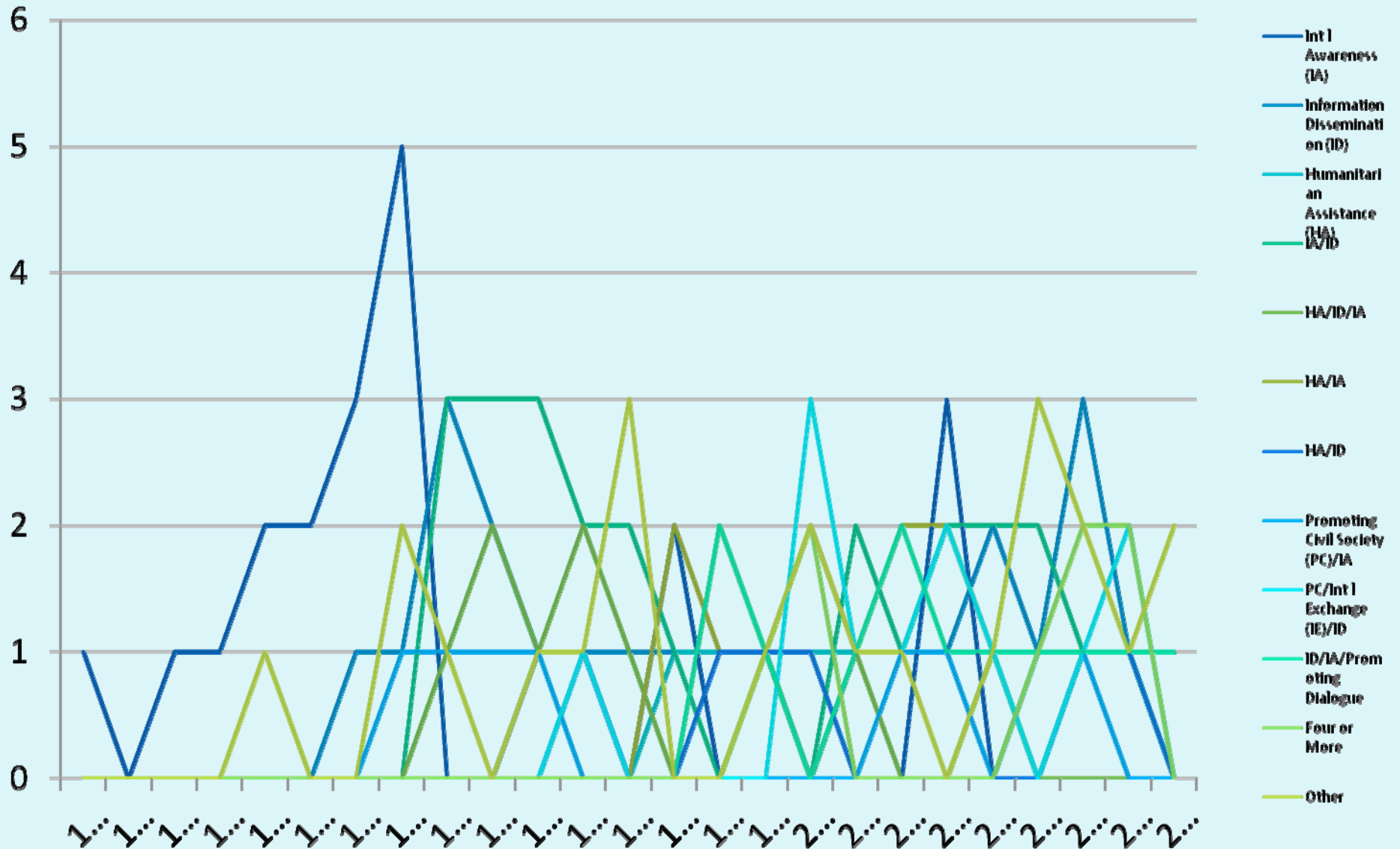
Program Areas

- International Awareness (IA) – information campaigns targeted at the international community, includes raising awareness about human rights violations
- Information Dissemination – information campaigns targeted at Cubans in Cuba, includes distribution of books and training material
- Humanitarian Aid – monetary assistance to Cubans in Cuba
- Promoting Civil Society – supporting incipient civil society organizations through training and other activities
- International Exchange – supporting travel to and from Cuba
- Promoting Dialogue – promoting communication among Cubans and others, both in Cuba and Internationally
- Human Rights – information campaigns in Cuba and internationally that focus solely on human rights abuses in Cuba
